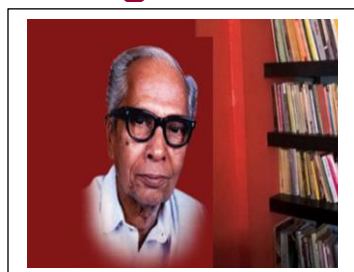

P N Panicker died on 19 June 1995, at age 86. The Government of Kerala acknowledged his contributions and ordered that 19 June be observed, annually, as *Vaayanadinam* "READING DAY" with a week-long series of activities at schools to honor his contributions to the cause of literacy, education and Library Movement.
